## **DISCUSSION**:

The Buffalo Erie Niagara Land Improvement Corporation (BENLIC) acquired the property of 465 Broad Street, City of Tonawanda by bidding the total amount of back taxes owed on the property at City of Tonawanda's In Rem Foreclosure Auction in September 2014. BENLIC used funding from the New York State Attorney General's (OAG) Office Community Revitalization Initiative grant award to significantly rehabilitate the property. OAG funds were invested into 465 Broad – a 936sq. ft., single-family home - to make the structure attractive to a responsible home buyer. BENLIC listed the property for sale on May 5, 2016 at price of \$89,900.



BENLIC staff has reviewed the offer s including respective Property Purchase Applications and Homebuyer Applications. The property is one of eight the Corporation has designated to serve residents whose income is no more than 120% of the Area Median Income for Erie County; the designation is in accordance with BENLIC's contract with the OAG. The purpose of the proposed disposition is congruent with BENLIC's mission to return property to productive use.
