DISCUSSION:

BENLIC acquired the property at 286 Pilgrim in Tonawanda by way of the Erie County In Rem foreclosure auction in 2016. The intent was to renovate the property, which occupies a corner lot in a quiet residential neighborhood where property values are strong, and most homes are in good condition. However, upon gaining access to the property, it became clear that it was vacant for some time. Building inspector Corey Baskerville indicated the structural disrepair was such that one should exercise extreme caution when entering. BENLIC informed the Town of Tonawanda of the structure's condition and the Town promptly condemned the structure, and suggested immediate demolition. Despite this unforeseen delay, this property represents a prime candidate for a modular new-build.

The demolition work was subsequently submitted for bid on March 3, 2017.



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ACTION:

WHEREAS, the Buffalo Erie Niagara Land Improvement Corporation wishes to approve a bid and enter into contract for demolition services of the property of 286 Pilgrim Road, Town of Tonawanda, New York; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Corporation's Procurement Policy section B(2)(c), the desired services were put out to bid on March 3, 2017 with a deadline to submit bids of March 15, 2017; and
