DISCUSSION:

BENLIC received a grant from LISC (Local Initiatives Support Corporation) in the amount of \$180,000.00 to explore the development of urban infill on select vacant lots in the City of Buffalo. The lots at 36-38 Longnecker Street in the Lovejoy community were selected due to their strategic location and ability to strengthen a historically healthy, low-moderate income community.

The Request for Proposals was released on December 4, 2017, with a submission deadline of December 20, 2017.
