DISCUSSION:

The Buffalo Erie Niagara Land Improvement Corporation (BENLIC) acquired the property of 332 Wabash Avenue, Village of Kenmore via Erie County In-Rem Auction in 2015. BENLIC used funding from the New York State Attorney General's (OAG) Office Community Revitalization Initiative grant award to rehabilitate the home. BENLIC listed the property for sale on March 15, 2018 at a price of \$124,900. The home has undergone a full rehab with significant foundation stabilization work. As a OAG CRI funded project, the home is available only to homebuyers who meet pre-determined income limits.



BENLIC staff has reviewed the offers including respective Property Purchase Applications and Homebuyer Applications. The purpose of the proposed disposition is congruent with BENLIC's mission to return property to productive use.

BENLIC Cost: \$23,252 - OAG Funded: \$131,112
