## **DISCUSSION:**

The Corporation issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Strategic and Financial Plan Consulting Services on May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Enterprise Community Partners, Inc. (Enterprise), in partnership with the New York State Attorney General, awarded 10 municipalities participating in the New York State Anti-Displacement Learning Network funds to implement strategies to address community displacement. BENLIC was part of the Buffalo Anti-Displacement Learning Network and was specifically awarded \$25,000 toward organization sustainability planning. The purpose for the issuance of the RFP was to find a consultant to assist in the strategic planning and financial planning for the Corporation to ensure sustainability as it grows and changes. The RFP was submitted directly to national and local consulting firms and posted online on the BENLIC website and on the RFP Database website. Two responses were received – JBK Consulting and Asakura Robinson.

## **ACTION:**

WHEREAS, the Buffalo Erie Niagara Land Improvement Corporation wishes to enter into an agreement with a qualified, local consulting firm for strategic and financial plan services;

WHERAS, pursuant to the Corporation's Procurement Policy Section E, the desired services were solicited on May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021, with a deadline to submit responses by June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021;
